- What is the source of authority in religion?
 - God, the source of all truth.

 John 17:17; James 1:17-18; Rom. 3:4
 - He has bestowed all authority upon His Son,
 Jesus. Matt. 28:18; Heb. 1:1-2
 - He is the lawgiver. John 12:48; Acts 3:22-23
 - He is the head of the church. Eph. 1:20-23

- What is the source of authority in religion?
 - Jesus delegated authority to his apostles. John 17:18; 14:26; Matt. 10:40; 1 John 4:6
 - The apostles wrote down their doctrine in what we called today the New Testament. 2 Pet. 3:1-2; 1 Cor. 14:37; Eph. 3:3-5

 - All things pertaining to life and godliness.

 - All truth. *John 16:13*
 - The salvation of man's soul. Rom. 1:16; James 1:21
 - Building us up and giving us and inheritance.
