- The fourth commandment:
 - What day of the week is the Sabbath?
Exo. 20:9-10
 - To whom was the command to keep the Sabbath? *Deut. 5:1-3; Mal. 4:4; Exo. 34:27-28*
 - What was meant to “keep the Sabbath holy”?
Deut. 5:12-15; Exo. 16:23; 35:1-3

The Ten Commandments:

“Remember The Sabbath Day, To Keep It Holy”

- Ways in which Israel broke the Sabbath day:
 - One man went out to get firewood on the Sabbath. ***Num. 15:32-36***
 - Others would buy and sell merchandise on the Sabbath. ***Neh. 13:15-21***
 - Priests also ignored the Sabbath day. ***Eze. 22:26***

The Ten Commandments:

“Remember The Sabbath Day, To Keep It Holy”

- The lesson for us today:
 - Remember that we are not under any part of the law. ***Col. 2:14, 16-17; Rom. 7:4***
 - We do not have a designated day as “holy”, but we do see the first Christians meeting on a particular day. ***Acts 20:7; 1 Cor. 16:1-2***
 - The only Sabbath promised to us is heaven. ***Heb. 4:3-11***
