The Ten Commandments:

“Honor Your Father And Your Mother”

- What did it mean to honor father and mother?
 - A custom of many nomad people was to abandon their parents when they no longer could help themselves or the family.
 - They were to respect and care for their parents. ***Lev. 19:32; exam. Ruth 1:7-17***
 - It also meant to listen to their counsel. ***Prov. 1:8-9; 13:1; 15:5***

The Ten Commandments:

“Honor Your Father And Your Mother”

- The penalty for dishonoring parents under the O.T.:
 - It would bring a curse from God.
Deut. 27:16; Prov. 30:17
 - In some cases, the penalty was death.
Exo. 21:15, 17; Lev. 20:9; Deut. 21:18-21
 - An example of how the Jews violated this commandment. ***Mark 7:9-13; Ezek. 22:7***

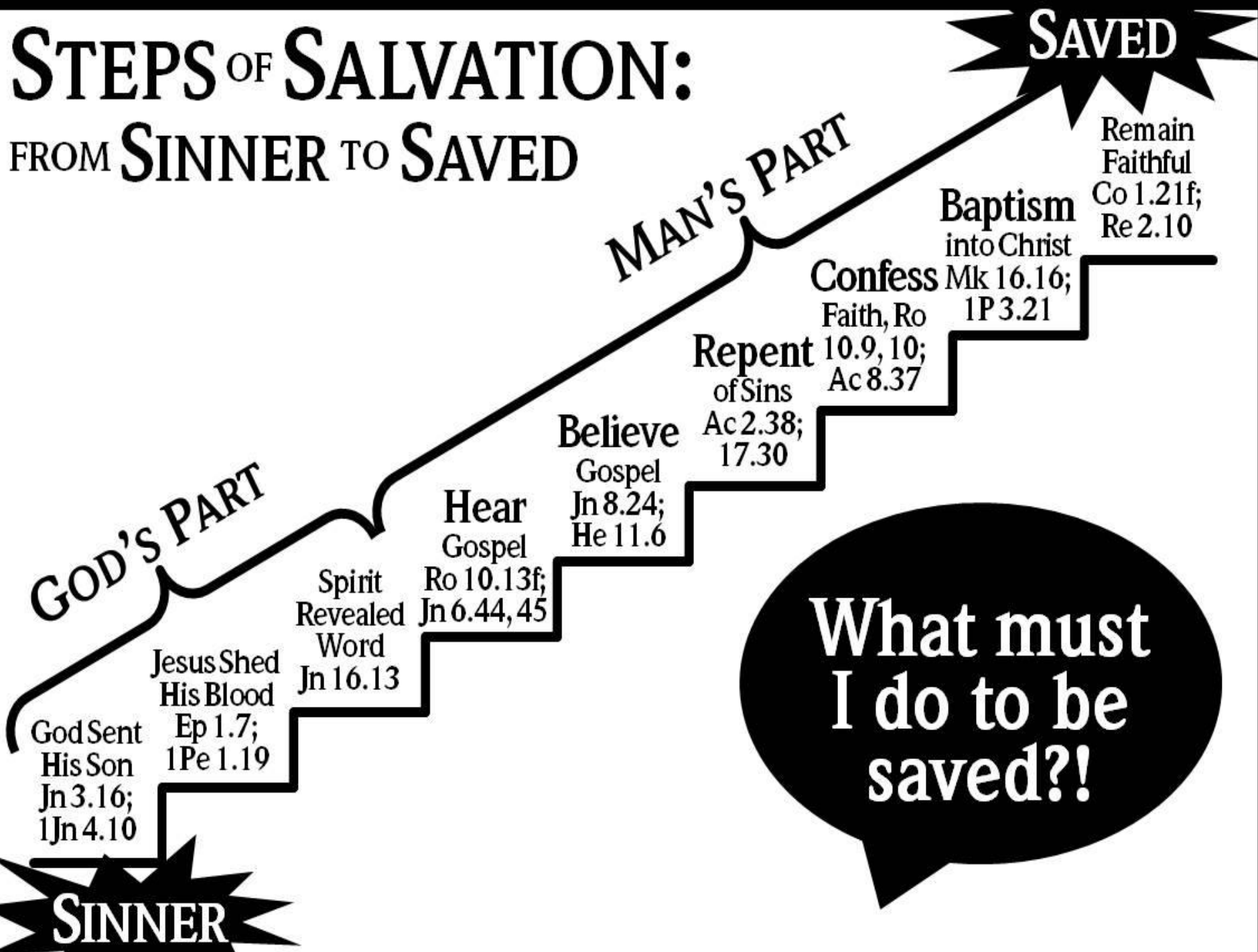
The Ten Commandments:

 - Remember that we are not under any part of the law. ***Col. 2:14, 16-17; Rom. 7:4***
 - Yet, this command is repeated word for word in the N.T. ***Eph. 6:1-3***
 - What this command requires of us:
 - Submit to them. ***Luke 2:51***
 - Accept their discipline.
Prov. 13:1; 12:1; 19:20
 - Provide for them in their old age.
