The Ten Commandments:

“You Shall Not Commit Adultery”

- Why such a command?
 - It was a common practice of those with power.
Gen. 12:14-17
 - God’s design has always been one man for one woman. ***Gen. 2:20-24***
 - But the hardness of man’s heart was not happy with this plan. ***Gen. 16:1-4; 29:25-28; 30:1-4, 9***

The Ten Commandments:

“You Shall Not Commit Adultery”

- Why such a command?
 - To protect women in these cases, God established laws for it. ***Exo. 21:10***
 - The penalty for committing adultery. ***Lev. 20:10; Deut. 22:22***

The Ten Commandments:

“You Shall Not Commit Adultery”

- Examples of some who violated this law:
 - The sons of Eli. ***1 Sam. 2:12, 22***
 - David committed adultery with the wife of Uriah. ***2 Sam. 11:2-4***
 - A couple of prophets in Judah. ***Jer. 29:23***

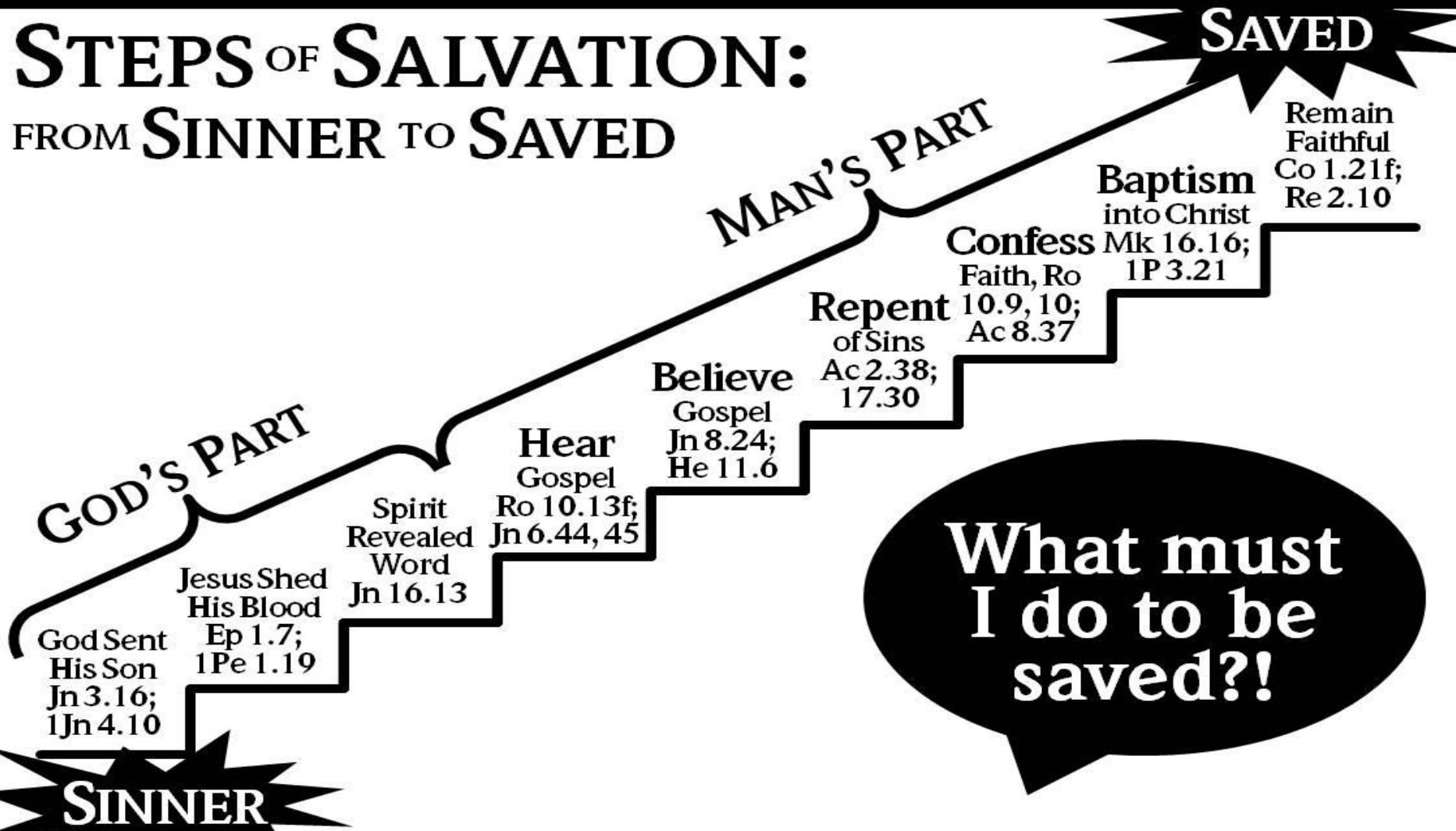
The Ten Commandments:

 - Remember that we are not under any part of the law. *Col. 2:14, 16-17; Rom. 7:4*
 - Yet, we are under a greater responsibility. *Matt. 5:27-30*
 - The penalty under the N.T. is eternal death. *1 Cor. 6:9-10; Gal. 5:19-21*
