The Ten Commandments:

“You Shall Not Bear False Witness...”

- What does the ninth commandment mean?
 - It does not say “Thou shall not lie” but “You shall not bear FALSE WITNESS against your neighbor”
 - Under the O.T. every truth was established by the word of witnesses.

Deut. 19:15; Num. 35:29-30

The Ten Commandments:

“You Shall Not Bear False Witness...”

- What does the ninth commandment mean?
 - It does not say “Thou shall not lie” but “You shall not bear FALSE WITNESS against your neighbor”
 - Among the things God hates is a “false witness”. ***Prov. 6:16-19***
 - The penalty for false witness.

Det. 19:16-21; Prov. 19:9

The Ten Commandments:

- Examples of those who violated this law:
 - Jezebel against Naboth.
1 Kings 21:7-13
 - The Jewish priests against Jesus.
Matt. 26:59-68
 - The Jewish priests against the apostle Paul.
Acts 24:1-9

The Ten Commandments:

“You Shall Not Bear False Witness...”

- The lesson for us today:
 - Remember that we are not under any part of the law. ***Col. 2:14, 16-17; Rom. 7:4***
 - But under the N.T. we are commanded to always speak with the truth. ***Eph. 4:15, 25***
 - The penalty under the N.T. is eternal death. ***Rev. 21:8***
