 - Without shame, it is difficult for some to come to repentance. 2 Cor. 7:9-12; 2 Sam. 12:1-7a, 13a
 - Sadly, some don't even know how to bush.
 Jer. 8:12

- To prevent others from doing the same.
 - Thus Paul commands to openly discipline. 1 Tim. 5:19-20
 - It is very easy to learn wrong behavior.
 Prov. 22:24-25
 - When discipline is executed, it helps prevent others in following. Acts 5:11

- Because we are accountable to the Lord.
 - We cannot make them change, but must warn them. Ezek. 3:17-21
 - Because of this, Paul was at ease with his ministry. Acts 20:26-27
