- If not what it claims to be, it is not a good book.
 2 Sam. 23:2; Jer. 30:2
 - ■3,800 times "Thus saith the Lord"
- Proofs of Inspiration:
 - Note: law of fair investigation
 - A person innocent until proven guilty

Does Bible Claim To Be Inspired - God Breathed?

- Proofs of Inspiration:
- Unity of Bible.
 - Not one, but 66 books.
- Fulfilled prophecy prove inspiration of Bible.
 - Many written hundreds of years in advance, but fulfilled in minute detail.

- Proofs of Inspiration:
- Archeological proof of inspiration.
- The style of the Bible as a proof of inspiration.
- It's survival as a proof of inspiration.1 Pet. 1:24-25
- Scientific accuracy as a proof of inspiration.
