 - **■**Empty space in the north. *Job 26:7*
 - Suspension of the earth in space. Job 26:7

 - **■**Life in the blood. *Lev.* 17:10-16

 - ■Water cycle. *Eccl.* 1:7

 - The *possibility* and *probability* of a revelation from God. *Mark 10:27; Luke 1:37*
 - The necessity of a revelation.
 - ■We cannot know God's will by nature alone. Rom. 1:19-24; Ps. 19:1-4

 - The <u>possibility</u> and <u>probability</u> of a revelation from God. <u>Mark 10:27; Luke 1:37</u>
 - The necessity of a revelation.
 - We cannot know God's will by intuition.

Rom. 1:25; Jer. 10:23; Prov. 16:25; Exam. Acts 17:23

What is the purpose of the Bible?

 - The *possibility* and *probability* of a revelation from God. *Mark 10:27; Luke 1:37*
 - The necessity of a revelation.
 - **■**We cannot know God's will by human wisdom.
 - 1 Cor. 1:21; Isa. 55:8-9

What is the Purpose of the Bible?

- Can we understand this revelation?
 - □ God intended for us to understand it. *Isa. 55:11*
 - God promised we can understand it. *Matt. 13:15;*John 12:48; Eph. 3:3-5; 5:17
- Does Bible claim to be a mystery?
 - Word "mystery" in N.T. refers to O.T. and not to the revelation of Christ given through apostles.

Rom. 16:25-26; Eph. 3:3-5; 1 Cor. 1:25-26; 2:6-10
