- Determine the meaning of words
 - Where do we go for definitions?
 - Dictionary.
 - Lexicon.
 - Concordance.
 - Bible itself. Other translations.

Meaning Of Words

□ Proper definitions and synonyms.

□ Examples:

■ Baptize (sprinkle or immerse).

Acts 8:38; Rom. 6:4

■ Cup (container or contents).

Luke 22:17, 20; 1 Cor. 11:25-26

Meaning Of Words

- Some words can be used in such a way to give a different meaning
 - Tempt. *Gen. 22:1 (KJV) vs. Jas. 1:13*
 - In a good sense
Jn. 6:6; Rev. 2:2
 - In a bad sense (to try by soliciting to evil)
Jas. 1:13; Matt. 4:3

Meaning Of Words

- Some words can be used in such a way to give a different meaning
 - Works. *Eph. 2:8-9 vs. Jas. 2:24*
 - Paul's usage
 - Works of Law. *Gal. 2:16, 21*
 - Works of our righteousness. *Titus 3:5*
 - James' usage
 - Works of obedience. *Jas. 2:14, 17-18, 20-23*

Meaning Of Words

- Some words can be used in such a way to give a different meaning
 - Judge. *1 Cor. 5:12 vs. Jas. 4:11*
 - 1 Cor. 5:12 refers to estimate - examine evidence.
 - By their fruits ye shall know them. *Jn. 7:24*

Meaning Of Words

- Some words can be used in such a way to give a different meaning
 - Hate. *Luke 14:26 vs. 1 John 3:15*
 - Hate - despise, wish evil. *1 Jn. 3:15*
 - Hate - love less. *Gen. 29:33; Matt. 10:37*
