***Gen. 4:9***
  - We should have the attitude of Jesus.

# The Parable Of The Good Samaritan

***Luke 10:30-35***

- The parable.
  - A man in need of help. ***Luke 10:30***
    - A man apparently with no way to repay any help. ***Prov. 19:17; Gal. 6:10***
  - A man representing God on earth acted as if he saw nothing. ***Luke 10:31***
    - Our love for God cannot be true if we have no love for fellow man. ***1 John 3:16-19; 4:20-21***

# The Parable Of The Good Samaritan

## *Luke 10:30-35*

- The parable.
  - A man who was born a servant of God did the same. *Luke 10:32*
    - Yet the Creator set the example of serving others. *Matt. 20:25-28*
  - A Samaritan went out of his way to help this man. *Luke 10:33-35*
    - Samaritans were not liked by the Jews. *John 4:9; 2 Kings 17:33*

# The Parable Of The Good Samaritan

***Luke 10:30-35***

- The application.
  - The lawyer is asked to make a judgment.  
***Luke 10:36-37a***
  - “Go and do the same” ***Luke 10:37b; Matt. 25:34-40***
  - Don’t rely only on the fact that we are God’s children. ***John 8:39-44; Matt. 13:40-42***
  - Don’t help only those who may be able to help you in return. ***Matt. 5:43-48***
