# What Does The Scriptures Say About The Holy Spirit?

- Some things we have clearly established from our past lessons:
  - Jehovah, the Father, is God.  
*Gen. 26:24; Exo. 6:3*
  - Jesus, the Christ, is God. *Titus 2:13*
  - The Holy Spirit, is not the Father nor the Son.  
*Eph. 4:4-6*

- Is the Holy Spirit a person?
  - Some characteristics:
    - He guides. *John 16:13*
    - He speaks. *1 Tim. 4:1-2*
    - He teaches. *John 14:26*
    - He extends fellowship. *2 Cor. 13:14*
    - He creates. *Job. 33:4; Ps. 104:30*

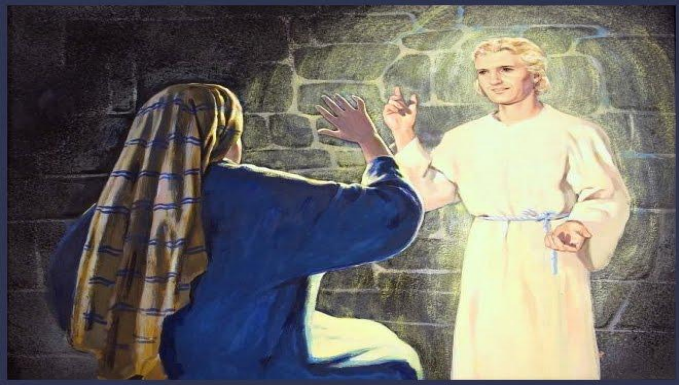
# What Does The Scriptures Say About The Holy Spirit?

- Is the Holy Spirit God?
  - The Holy Spirit has all the attributes of Godhood:
    - He is eternal. ***Heb. 9:14***
    - He is omniscient. ***1 Cor. 2:10-11***
    - He is omnipotent. ***Micah 3:8; Job 26:13***
    - He is omnipresent. ***Ps. 139:7***

# What Does The Scriptures Say About The Holy Spirit?

- Necessary inference makes clear that the Holy Spirit is God.
  - If the Holy Spirit is not God, then speaking against someone lesser than God is the worse sin.  
*Matt. 12:31-32; Mark 3:28-29*
  - If the Holy Spirit is not God, then Jesus could not be called the Son of God. *Matt. 1:18, 19-20; Luke 1:30-33, 34-35*
