- ⦿ Moses answered: “a staff” ***Exo. 4:1-4***
 - A shepherd’s staff became the tool of power and deliverance. ***Exo. 4:15-17; 7:14-17; 14:15-16***
- ⦿ Joshua answered: “a javelin” ***Josh. 8:18-19***
 - The word of God is a powerful sword.
Rev. 1:16; Heb. 4:12

What Is That In Your Hand?

Exo. 4:2

- ⦿ Shamgar answered: “an oxgoad” **Judg. 3:31**
 - What we might think is not useful for the task can be used by God to accomplish great things.
1 Cor. 1:26-28; 2:1-5
- ⦿ Gideon and his 300 men answered: “trumpets, pitchers and torches” **Judg. 7:16-22**
 - We are to use similar tools to defeat this evil age.
Isa. 58:1; Matt. 5:14-16; 2 Tim. 2:20-21

- ⦿ David answered: “a sling” *1 Sam. 17:40-43*
 - 2 things made this sling effective: a trained hand, and coming in the name of the Lord. *1 Sam. 17:44-50*
- ⦿ A Jewish boy answered: “5 barley loaves and 2 fish”
John 6:5-9
 - Though our means may be but little, they can multiply if we place them in the hands of the Lord.
John 6:10-13
