Exam. Exo. 20:8, 12

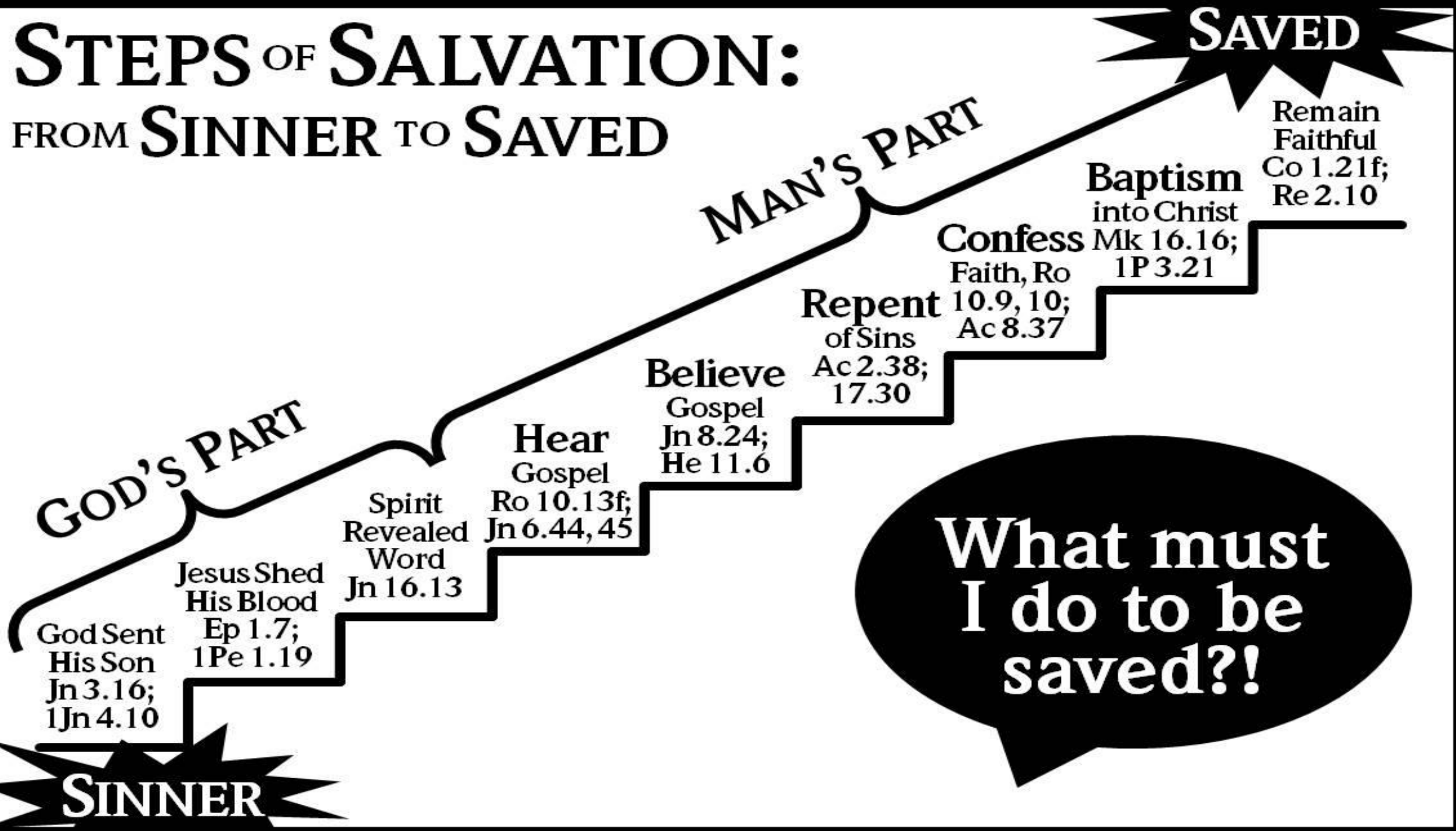
