- Financial troubles.
  - The more you have does not mean the happier you will be. Eccl. 2:4-11; 5:10-12
  - Happiness is not about what we have on earth, but in heaven. Luke 12:15, 16-21; Matt. 6:19-21
  - Learn to be content with what we have. Phil. 4:11-13; 1 Tim. 6:6-8

- In-law problems.
  - We must leave one relationship in order to establish a new one. *Gen.* 2:23-24; *Prov.* 14:1; 18:22
  - Avoid venting your problems with your kin. *Prov.* 29:11; 23:25; 18:17 cf. Isa. 49:15
