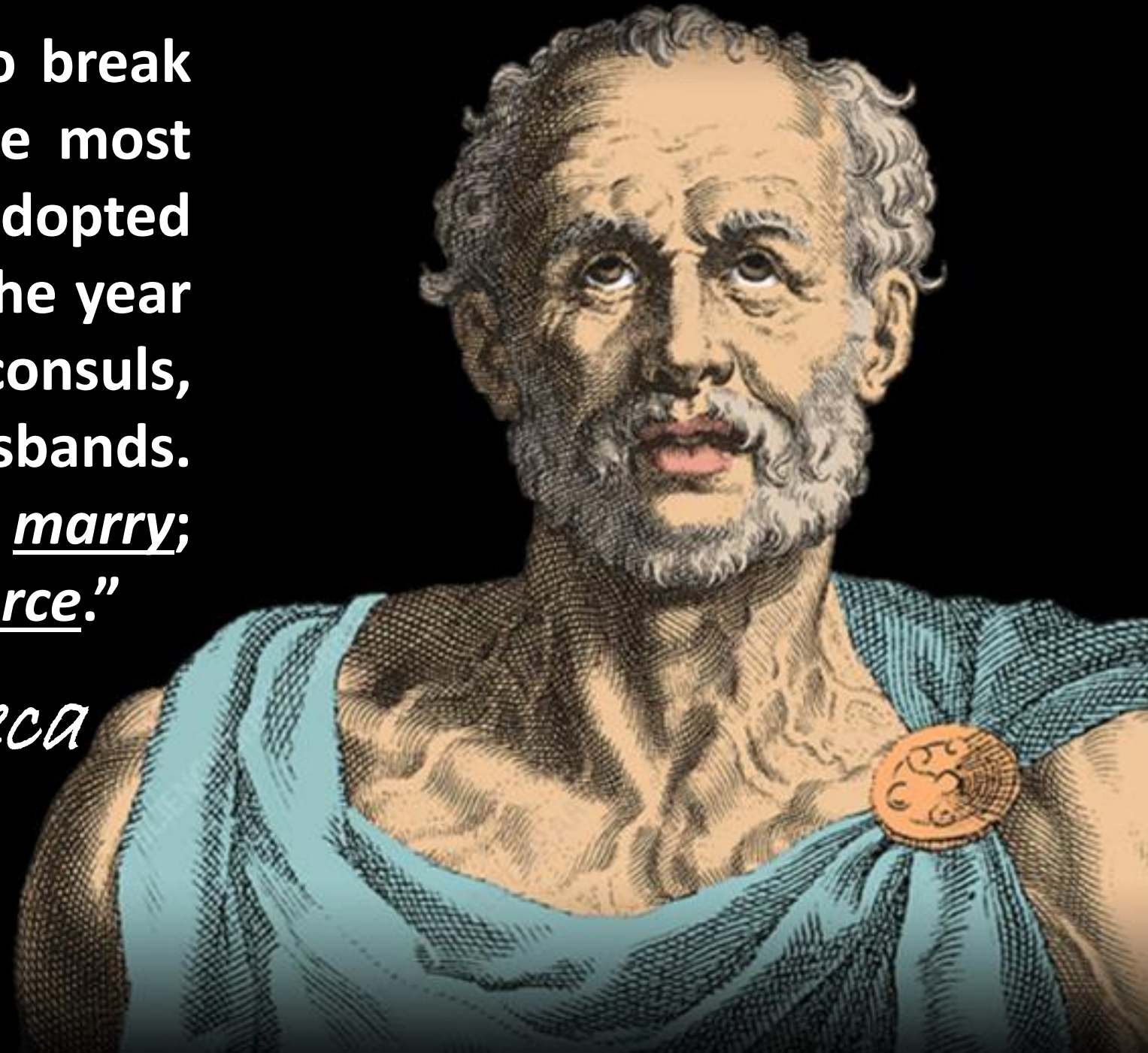


Common Errors On Divorce And Who Can Remarry

Common Errors On Divorce And Who Can Remarry

- ▶ Jesus' teaching on divorce does not apply to the non-Christian. Supposed proof text: *Matt. 19:9*
 - ▶ "Whoever" of Matt. 19:9 applies to everyone.
Acts 17:30; 2:21
- ▶ Doesn't baptism correct any divorce and subsequent remarriage? Supposed proof text: *1 Cor 6:9-11*
 - ▶ Repentance is required for every and any sin.
Matt. 14:3-4; John 8:11

Common Errors On Divorce And Who Can Remarry

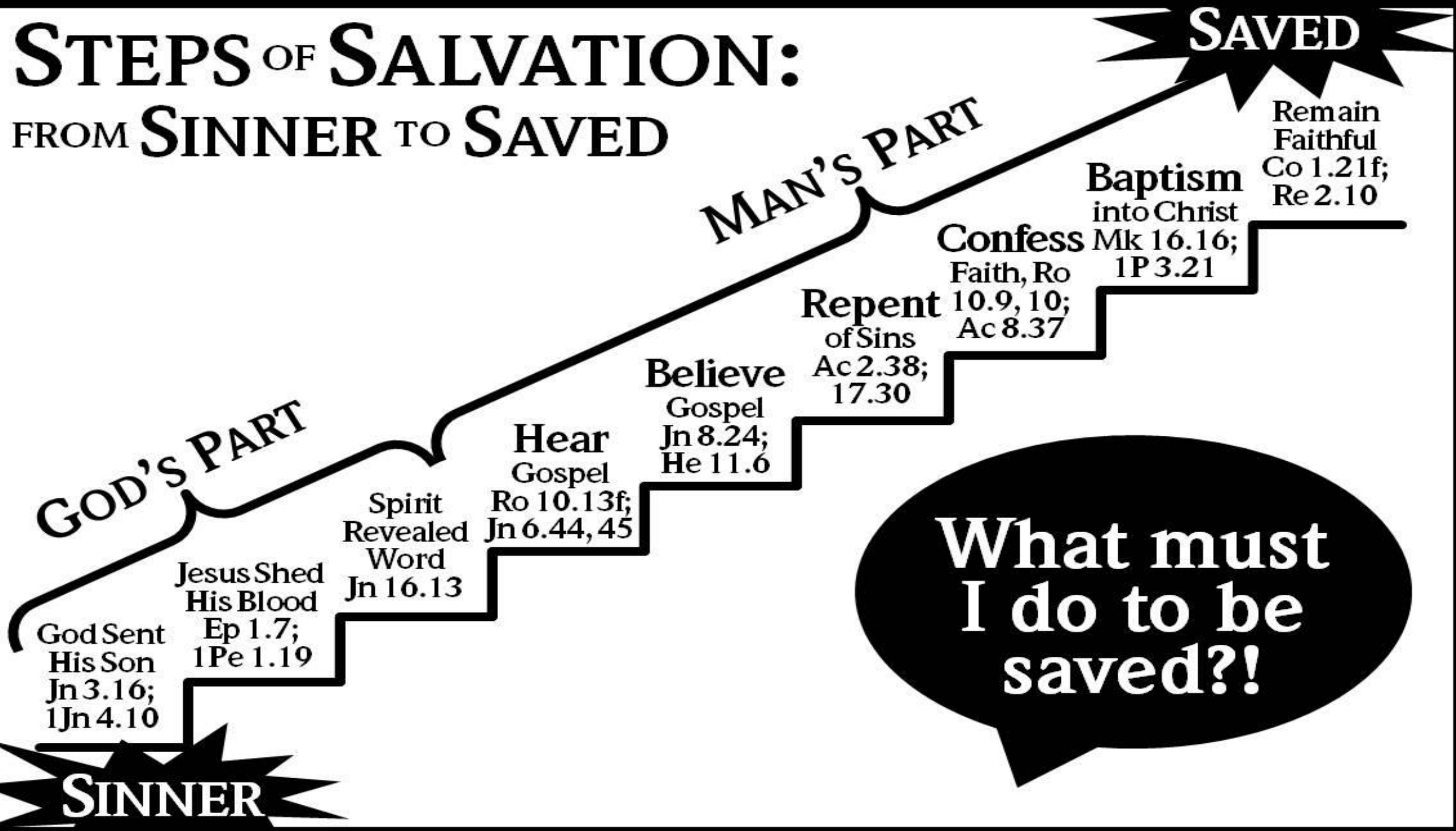
- ▶ If there is fornication and then a divorce, both are free to remarry. Supposed proof text: ***Matt. 19:9***
 - ▶ Such would mean that one can benefit for one's sin. ***Prov. 13:15; Luke 16:18***
- ▶ God's desire is for all to be married. Supposed proof text: ***1 Cor. 7:2***
 - ▶ But if such understanding is true, to whom will vs. 11 apply? ***1 Cor. 7:10-11***

Common Errors On Divorce And Who Can Remarry

- ▶ The teachings of Jesus are part of the Law of Moses.
Supposed proof text: ***Gal. 4:4***
 - ▶ Yet we find that the teachings of Jesus are the foundation of the New Covenant. ***Luke 16:16; Mark 1:1; Heb. 2:1-3***
- ▶ Death is the only way to sever the marriage covenant.
Supposed proof text: ***Rom. 7:1-3***
 - ▶ That would make the teaching of Jesus applicable to no one. ***Matt. 19:9; 5:32***
