- Orphans with living fathers.
 - Fatherhood involves great responsibility.
 1 Tim. 5:8; Eph. 6:4
 - Teaching, training children was expected as seen in:
 - The example of Abraham. Gen. 18:17-19
 - The command of the law of Moses. *Deut. 6:4-9*
 - The statement of David. Ps. 78:5-8

- Orphans with living fathers.
 - It takes a lot of work to be a good father.
 - One must begin early and be regular. Prov. 19:18
 - Develop your relationship while they are still children.
 Prov. 22:6
 - Learn how to communicate. *Prov. 1:8-9*
 - Responsibility to discipline our children. *Prov.* 29:15, 17; 13:24

- Discipline is an act of love.
 - If you spare the rod you will spoil the child. Prov. 22:15; 23:13-14
 - Effective correction is not done by the rod alone
 - Children need proper instruction. *Prov. 2:1-5; 2 Tim. 3:15*
 - Teaching behavior involves more than just social graces. Luke 2:52; Prov. 9:10; 14:27; 19:23
