 - They were not unknown ailments. Mark 5:25-29

 - They confirmed the truth, not error.

- How can we know that these miracles don't happen today?
 - Their intended purpose has ended.
 John 20:30-31
 - The written word has replaced the need for miracles. 2 Tim. 3:16-17; Rom. 10:17; 2 Cor. 5:7
 - The means for obtaining the gifts of the Holy Spirit is unavailable. Acts 8:14-19; 2 Tim. 1:6
