- **X** Courage when facing fear.
 - + Goliath, the Philistine champion had brought fear upon the entire Israelite army. 1 Sam. 17:1-11
 - + When David heard the challenge, he was ready to answer. 1 Sam. 17:22-24, 26, 32-37
 - + He went forth armed with his staff, a sling and five stones. 1 Sam. 17:38-40
 - + David had more than that, he also had faith in God. 1 Sam. 17:43-50

- Courage when facing anxiety.
 - + Saul sought to kill David. 1 Sam. 18:7-12
 - + David understood that Saul had no real reason for trying to kill him. *Psa. 69:4*
 - + It was his faith in God that allowed him to overcome anxiety in the mist of problems.

Psa. 23:1-5a

- **x** Courage when facing revenge.
 - + He had several opportunities for revenge against Saul:
 - ×In the cave at En-Gedi. 1 Sam. 24:1-4, 6-7
 - *At the camp at Ziph. 1 Sam. 26:7-8, 9-10
 - + He understood that any revenge was not up to man. 1 Sam. 24:12; Rom. 12:19

- **X** Courage when facing his own sin.
 - + David had greatly sinned concerning Bathsheba and Uriah the Hittite.
 - + He was guilty of adultery. 2 Sam. 11:1-5
 - + In trying to cover his sin, he became guilty of murder. 2 Sam. 12:9
 - + By this he created an opportunity for the heathen to blaspheme. 2 Sam. 12:14a

- Courage when facing his own sin.
 - + How did David handle this?
 - + He immediately confessed his sin. 2 Sam. 12:13
 - + He acted responsibly and endured the consequences of his actions. *Psa. 51:3-4*
