Knowledge Without Application

- Solomon possessed great knowledge.
 - + He was given wisdom and knowledge by the Lord. 2 Chr. 1:6-12; 1 Kings 4:29-34
 - + He impressed leaders of other nations with his knowledge. 1 Kings 10:1-10, 23-24
 - + He used his knowledge and wisdom in ruling the people. 1 Kings 3:16-28

- * Solomon possessed great knowledge.
 - + Solomon had knowledge in the following three areas:
 - **XEX** He knew the need for knowledge. *Prov. 1:1-5*
 - **XEXAMPLE 2015** **He knew the importance of proper influence. *Prov. 1:8-19; 22:24-25; 6:27-28*
 - **Solomon knew the need of worshiping only God. 2 Chr. 7:16-20**

- * Problems in Solomon's life.
 - + During the course of his life, he married 700 wives and took 300 concubines. 1 Kings 11:1-3
 - + He should have known the Lord's wishes regarding man and his wife. *Gen. 2:24; Deut. 17:17-19*
 - + He should have listened to his own teachings on influences. 1 Kings 11:4-13
 - + He did not listen to the word of the Lord regarding worshiping Him only. *Deut. 6:13-15*

- Lessons to learn from Solomon's life.
 - + Knowledge of God's Word does not guarantee you will always make the right decisions.

 James 1:21-25; 2:14-18
 - +We should pay careful attention to avoid bad influences within our life. 1 Cor. 15:33; 5:6-7
