Ps. 40:1-5, 16-17

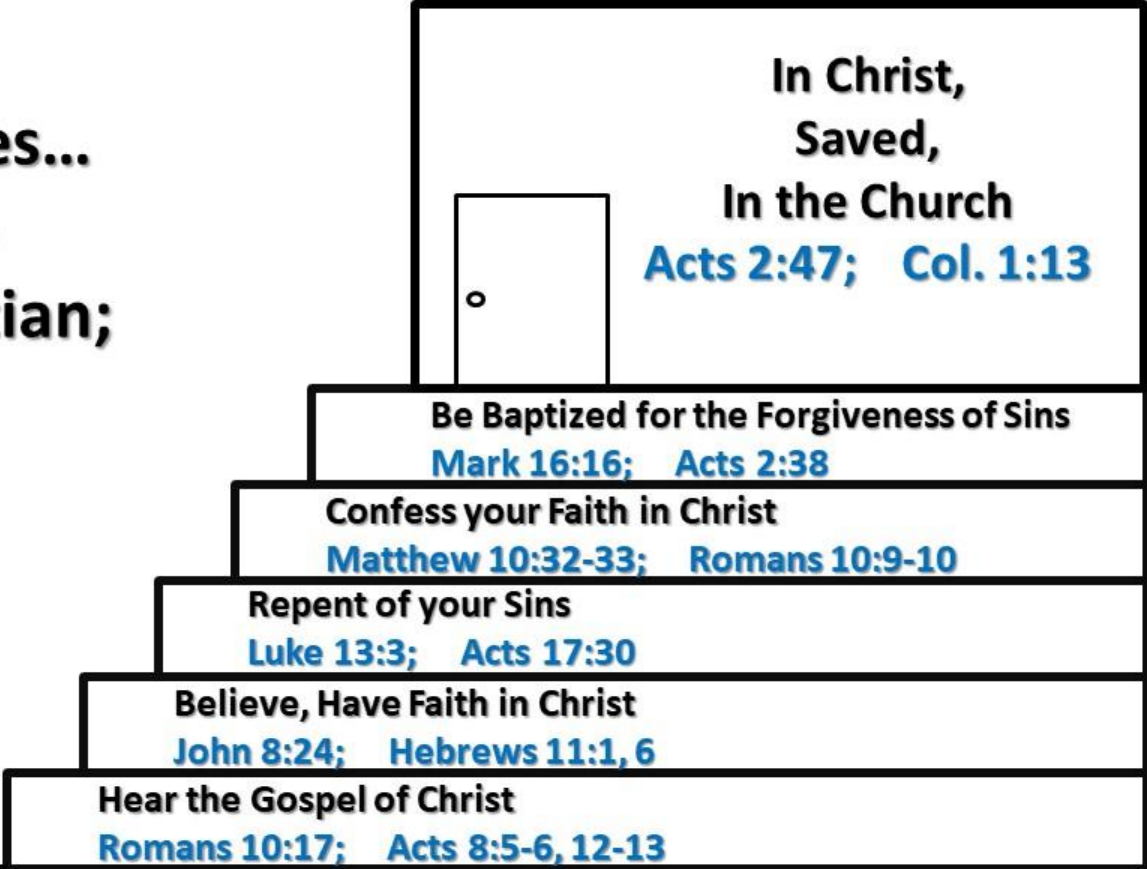
- God does allow us to go through some afflictions.

 - How does He do this? ***Ps. 41:9-10; 1 Pet. 3:13-14***

- God can bring good out of affliction. ***Rom. 8:28***
 - Nothing can separate us from the love of God.
Rom. 8:31-37
 - Remember the attitude of Joseph? ***Gen. 50:20***
 - Any affliction is only temporary. ***2 Cor. 4:16-18***
 - Afflictions produce hope and a blessing.
